RE: **USH 41/Hall Ave Railroad Crossing to be Repaired**

The Canadian National Railroad (CN) is announcing plans to repair the USH 41/Hall Ave railroad crossing in Marinette, WI.

Beginning Monday, October 16, 2017, at 7 a.m. CN is performing asphalt and crossing surface repairs at the crossing. In order to perform repairs, it will be necessary to close the highway at the crossing. USH 41/Hall Ave will be closed at the railroad tracks and a signed detour will be in effect.

The road is expected to reopen by 5 p.m. on Friday, October 20, 2017.
