THE CITY OF MARINETTE IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE A PROGRAM FOR EARTH DAY, SATURDAY, APRIL 22ND, 2017. IN CELEBRATION OF THIS PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WILL ACCEPT E-CYCLING AT NO COST TO CITY OF MARINETTE RESIDENTS. ITEMS ACCEPTED INCLUDE: TV'S, COMPUTERS, MONITORS, PC TOWERS, KEYBOARDS, MOUSE, STEREOS, RADIOS, ECT. MICROWAVE OVENS, REFRIDGERATORS, STOVES AND OTHER "WHITE GOODS" WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THIS EVENT WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE CLEVELAND AVE DUMPSITE, WITH ALL USUAL DUMP ACTIVITIES ALSOTAKING PLACE.

THE MARINETTE WATER UTILITY IS ALSO PARTICIPATING IN THIS EVENT. THE UTILITY WILL PROVIDE FLOURESCENT LIGHT BULB RECYCLING AT THE CLEVELAND AVE DUMPSITE. THE FOLLOWING LIGHT BULBS WILL BE ACCEPTED:

4' & 8' FLOURESCENT TUBES

COMPACT-STYLE FLOURESCENT BULBS, INCLUDING THE SCREW IN TYPE

MERCURY VAPOR BULBS

METAL HALIDE BULBS

HIGH & LOW PRESSURE SODIUM VAPOR BULBS

THERMOSTATS CONTAINING MERCURY WILL ALSO BE ACCEPTED. PLEASE HANDLE ALL BULBS SAFELY AND HAVE THEM IN A BOX TO PREVENT BREAKAGE.

THE DUMPSITE WILL BE OPEN FROM 8:00AM UNTIL 2:00PM. AS A REMINDER, THIS PROGRAM IS OPEN TO CITY RESIDENTS WHO HAVE A CURRENT CITY SERVICES CARD.
