The attached permit is approved with the following conditions:

- Permittee shall be responsible for Notifying Diggers Hotline before starting excavation.
- If the street will be closed, Contractor is responsible for notifying Emergency Personnel 24 hours before closure by calling Marinette County Central Dispatch @ 715-732-7332.
- All street surfaces disturbed during construction shall be permanently restored with like materials, either hot mix asphalt or concrete pavement, according to City of Marinette standards.
- Lawn restoration shall consist of topsoil, seed fertilizer and mulch, according to City of Marinette standards.
- Any damage or impact to paved areas will be restored with like materials at the expense of the Permittee. This applies to ALL paved areas regardless of its pre-existing condition. The City will have sole discretion regarding the extent of required restoration. Concrete and asphalt restoration shall be done by a city-approved contractor.
- Permittee shall provide all required traffic control.
- Contractor is responsible to maintain the opening at all times, with gravel, cold patch, etc... to keep area safe.
- All restoration shall be completed within 5 working days from the time of completion of work under this permit. If the restoration is not complete in 5 working days the city will restore the opening and deduct the cost of restoration from the contractor's deposit.
- Permittee shall comply with State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources erosion control.
- Permittee shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws.
- Permittee shall only perform work within City of Marinette right-of-way as described and shown on the attachments in above mentioned work order. No other work is permitted.
- Permittee shall warranty all restoration for a period of 12 months from the time the restoration is completed and approved by the City.
- All costs associated with the work under this street opening permit shall be the responsibility of the permittee as a condition of this permit, including, but not limited to: street restoration, turf restoration, and any other damages to city property resulting from work performed under this permit.
- Permittee must notify the City Public Works Department for an inspection within two (2) days of completing all work, including lawn restoration. (715-732-5134).
- Tap back of Catch Basin with a core drill and mortar sump pump discharge pipe. Sump pump hose shall be flush with catch basin inside wall.
- Saw out existing sidewalk at joints; compact granular backfill; and replace sidewalk with poured concrete.
