MARINETTE MARKET RULES

- 1) This Market is for vendor made and/or grown items within the Marinette, Menominee & Oconto county of Wisconsin and Michigan.
- 2) Membership applications are to be completely filled out and turned into the Community Development Office at City Hall 1905 Hall Avenue Marinette, WI, Marinette Welcome Center or Market Manager.
- 3) Vendors must also provide proof of licensing (if necessary) for products sold at time of application. For questions about necessary licensing please contact UW-extension at 715.732.7510.
- 4) The market does not set prices for vendors, but all vendors must be considerate of other vendors when marking prices for their items. We will not allow price gouging at the Market. If this happens, the market manager will ask the vendor to refrain from selling that item at a low price. If it continues, the vendor will be asked to leave the market.
- 5) Representatives of the market shall have the right to conduct an inspection of the farm or production area of a vendor if necessary to determine validity.
- 6) Vendors will not be allowed to operate more than one stand but may pay fees accordingly for a larger space.
- 7) Vendors are required to be courteous and professional towards other vendors & customers.
 - No drinking alcohol in the market area
 - No smoking in the market area
- 8) Radios noise should not disturb other vendors or customers.
- 9) Vendors are not allowed to bring pets into the market area.

State Laws MUST be followed for all products sold, Including:

- 10) All samples offered by vendors must meet the following criteria:
 - Must be stored in a clean, covered container until serving
 - Clean, disposable plastic gloves must be worn when cutting or handling samples
 - Cutting surfaces must be smooth, non-absorbent & easily cleanable
 - Toothpicks or disposable utensils must be used to distribute the samples
 - Samples should be adequate size and proportionally spaced to minimize customer handling
 - The vendor must have control over sample at all times
 - Samples must be maintained at the correct temperature if applicable
 - All vendors giving out free samples MUST have a waste container in a prominent place for the public.

- 11) All meat, poultry, eggs & fish must be farm raised from your property.

- 12) Meats, poultry, eggs & fish must be refrigerated or stored in ice at all times while presented at the market. The products must be held at or below 40 degrees Fahrenheit.

- 13) Juice, honey and maple syrup must be made on the vendor's property.

- 14) Hours of operation:
 - Setup: 1:00PM-2:00PM every Friday
 - Market Hours: 2:00-6:00PM every Friday
 - Teardown: 6:00PM-7:00PM every Friday

- 15) At the end of each market day, all trash needs to be properly bagged and left in the designated garbage area.

- 16) Under Recreational Immunity Law within the State of Wisconsin, the City of Marinette is immune from liability insurance, if, no admission fee is charged to visit the events on the Island. Vendors are advised to have their own liability insurance, but it is not required.
