1. Alderperson Jason Flatt, Committee Chairperson, called the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic and Lights Committee regular meeting to order at 04:41 PM in the Marinette Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave, Marinette WI.
2. Upon a call of the roll, the following Committee members attendance was recorded as follows:

3. **Approving Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee prior month meeting minutes.**
Alderpersons Kowalski moved/Oitzinger seconded and all concurred, to approve, as presented, the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee regular meeting minutes from 4/19/21.
4. **Discussion and possible action regarding handicap parking spots on Ella Court between Stephenson Street and Court Street.**
Included in today's packet are 2 layouts that showed options for handicap parking on Ella Court between Stephenson and Court Street. Director of Public Works and Building Inspector Demlow were able to reach out to the Architect from the renovations on Ella Ct and discuss the options. Miller stated the regulations for the area would be 4 handicap stalls and 1 van accessibility with access isles. Miller Stated because the handicap parking is now a parking lot issue it should go to the Plan Commission for review. Miller also stated Marinette County should be contacted with the City's concerns. Alderperson Kowalski moved/ Oitzinger seconded and all concurred to forward to the Plan Commission for review, after further discussion the motions were withdrawn and Mayor Genisot will set up a meeting with the County to discuss the handicap parking issue on Ella Court between Stephenson Street and Court Street. No action was taken on the agenda item.
