**SUBJECT: Hall Avenue Pavement Markings and
Edge Line Cost Estimates**

A request was made to add white edge lines to Hall Avenue, from the round-about at STH 180 to Van Cleve Avenue.

Since this section of Hall Avenue is a connecting highway, Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WDOT) was contacted about painting edge lines. WDOT indicated the city can add pavement markings and lines without WDOT approval. However, painting edge lines for 12-foot travel lanes would only leave 3-feet between the edge line and the curb. A 3-foot wide "bike lane" is substandard and not advisable. WDOT suggested sharrow symbols as an alternative to edge lines.

The Board of Public Works requested a cost estimate to paint white edge lines and a cost estimate to paint sharrow symbols.

Cost Summary:

1. Edge Lines
 - ◆ Marinette County Highway Department would paint the new edge lines.
 - ◆ Painting would occur in 2022.
 - ◆ The cost to paint edge lines along both sides of Hall Avenue, from the round-about at STH 180 to Van Cleve Avenue is estimated at \$1,022.

2. Sharrow Symbols
 - ◆ Marinette Department of Public Works would paint the Sharrow Symbols.
 - ◆ Painting would occur in 2022.
 - ◆ The cost to paint the sharrow symbols along both sides of Hall Avenue, from the round-about at STH 180 to Van Cleve Avenue is estimated at \$1,316.
