Committee Chairperson Kowalski called the regular City of Marinette Finance & Insurance Committee meeting **to order** at 04:00 PM in Marinette City Hall Common Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave., Marinette WI.

1. **Upon a call of the roll** it was determined a quorum of Committee members were present and the following attendance was recorded:

2. **Approval of minutes.**
Alderpersons Skorik moved/Keller seconded and all concurred, to approve, as presented, the Finance and Insurance Committee meeting minutes from 02/22/23.
3. **Approval of February Monthly Expenditures.**
Alderpersons Klegin moved/Skorik seconded and all concurred, to recommend the Common Council approve February 2023 expenditures.
4. **February 2023 budget report.**

Alderpersons Keller moved/Skorik seconded and all concurred, to recommend the Common Council approve the budget amendment for Fire Dept. floor apparatus, City Hall Maintenance and Engineering vehicle.
7. **Discussion and possible recommendation to common council Building Inspection Fee Schedule forwarded from Plan Commission.**
Alderperson Skorik moved/ Klegin seconded and all concurred to recommend the Common Council approve as presented the Building Inspection Fee Schedule forwarded from Plan Commission.

City Treasurer/Finance Director Miller finalized scheduling for the upcoming audit. Miller also stated the City Hall Phone line system crashed with a power outage recently and she is working on getting quotes for a new system. The phones in City Hall are working but not able to get or retrieve any messages.
