4. **CONSIDERATION OF RECOMMENDATION REGARDING BID RESULTS FOR PRAIRIE ST & 10TH STREET, STREET AND UTILITY CONSTRUCTION, PROJECT NO. 2021-700.**

Aldersperson Kowalski moved/ Skorik seconded and upon a call of the roll **motion carried** by a vote of 8 ayes to 0 nays to **accept** the recommendation from the Board of Public Works and **approve** the low bid from Barley Trucking, PO Box 547 Menominee MI, 49858 in the amount of \$231,306.30 for Prairie St & 10th Street, Street and Utility Construction, Project No. 2021-700.

5. **CONSIDERATION OF RECOMMENDATION REGARDING BID RESULTS FOR CONCRETE AT LARGE.**
