

## CITY OF MARINETTE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES FROM JUNE 7, 2022

1. 1<sup>st</sup> Ward Alderperson Ken Keller, Board President called the Board of Public Works special meeting **to order** at 05:40 PM at Marinette City Hall Common Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave., Marinette WI.
2. **Upon a call of the roll** it was determined a quorum of the Board were present and attendance was documented as follows:

3. **Presentation from Graef regarding Project ID 9072-05-00, University Avenue Local Officials Meeting.**  
Included in today's packet is a project schedule and maps showing the estimated times and areas for the two projects. Andrew Schultz, representing Graef gave an overview of Project ID 9072-05-00 & Project ID 9995-00-66 and answered any questions the committee had. Schultz stated the projects will start early in 2023.
4. **Presentation from Graef regarding Project ID 9995-00-66, Prairie/6<sup>th</sup> Street Local Officials Meeting.**  
Combined with item 3 see above.
5. **Discussion and possible recommendation to the Common Council regarding paving Oak View Road.**  
City Engineer/ Director of Public Works Miller distributed a memorandum stating TYCO's contractor, Barley Trucking & Excavating, is restoring the Oak View Road pavement as a result of work related to the GETS installation. Barley's crews will pulverize the west lane of Oak View Road on June 8th from Edwin Street to north pavement limits, then compact the subgrade to eliminate any voids. The west lane will then be paved with three inches of asphalt. The east lane was not affected by TYCO's contractor during the GETS installation, and therefore, it will not be repaved by TYCO. Oak View Road was chip sealed in 2009, and it is now showing signs of aging and developing some cracks. Barley offered to pave the east lane concurrent with the west lane paving. The cost to pulverize, fine grade, and pave the east lane with asphalt is \$26,217.50.  
Alderperson Polzin moved/ Oitzinger seconded and all concurred to **recommend the Common Council approve** paving the East lane portion of Oak View Road in the amount of \$ 26,217.50

Alderperson Skorik moved/ Polzin seconded and all concurred to adjourn at **05:48 PM**.
