

CITY OF MARINETTE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FROM [JULY 19, 2022](#)

1. [1st](#) Ward Alderperson Ken Keller, Board President, **called** the **regular** Marinette Board of Public Works Meeting **to order** at [04:30](#) P.M. in the Common Council Chambers at Marinette City Hall, 1905 Hall Avenue, Marinette, WI.
2. **Upon a call of the roll** it was determined a quorum of the Board were present and attendance was documented as follows:

3. **Board of Public Works meeting minutes.**
Alderpersons Polzin moved/ **Finance Director/City Treasurer Miller** seconded, and all concurred, (Keller abstained) to approve the Board of Public Works regular meeting minutes from 6/21/22 & Special 7/6/22.
4. **Discussion and possible recommendation to the Common Council regarding the request from Emergency Rescue Squad, Inc. to close the Stephenson Island boat landing on Saturday, August 13.**
Greg Loll, representing the Emergency Rescue Squad was present to answer any questions regarding the request. Alderpersons Oitzinger moved/ Finance Director/City Treasurer Miller seconded and all concurred, to recommend the Common Council approve closing the City boat launch and Parking Lot on Stephenson Island on August 13th for the entire day.
5. **Discussion Railing on USH 41 bridge parapet.**
Public Works Director/City Engineer Miller included in today's packet a memorandum regarding the USH 41 bridge Parapet Railing stating City staff discussed the USH 41 Bridge parapet wall railing with the WDOT and requested a list of qualified contractors who might be interested in this project. Miller stated the WDOT suggested removing the existing railing and purchasing new parapet railing. No action was taken on this agenda item.
6. **Discussion regarding 2023 and 2024 Street Reconstruction.**
Public Works Director/City Engineer Miller Included in today's packet is a list of Street Reconstruction projects and funding sources for 2023/ and 2024 for the committee to review. No action was taken on this agenda item.
7. **Discussion regarding handicapped ramp request.**
Included in today's packet the request of two additional handicap ramps and maps showing the requested areas. Alderperson Oitzinger stated one request is for the corner of Ella and Court St and the second is by the Marinette Welcome Center close to the walking bridge. Mayor Genisot stated the request to yellow hash out the one parking spot and curb cut for the handicap ramp at the Welcome Center can be done. The committee discussed the additional request and took no action at this time.
