

MARINETTE CIVIC AFFAIRS, CEMETERY, TRAFFIC & LIGHTS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES FROM 09/19/22

1. Alderperson Debbie Klegin, Committee Chairperson, **called** the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic and Lights Committee regular meeting **to order** at 04:41 PM in the Marinette Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave, Marinette WI.

4. **Discussion and possible recommendation to the Common Council, regarding traffic issues at Primary School (Merryman School) and Intermediate School (Park School) including Limited Parking and No Parking.**
City Engineer/Director of Public Works Miller distributed 2 maps and the current Marinette Municipal Code 10.0108. Miller stated there has been some concern with the new renovations at each school in regards to pedestrian and vehicle traffic. Recently the Mayor, City Engineer /Director of Public Works Miller, School Superintendent Corry Lambie and Tom Westlund met to discuss the concerns. The two maps distributed pictured areas of recommended no parking and limited parking for the committee to review. School Superintendent Corry Lambie stated the staff at each school is monitoring drop off and pick up areas. Lambie also stated that this is an adjustment as we educate the community on school safety. The schools are sending out correspondence to parents. The committee discussed further collaboration with the school system and will revisit the item at the October Civic Affairs meeting.
