2. **Upon a call of the roll**, the following Committee members attendance was recorded as follows:

3. **Approving Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee prior month meeting minutes.**
Alderpersons Mikutowski moved/Kowalski seconded and all concurred, to approve, as presented, the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee regular meeting minutes from 9/20/21.
4. **Update regarding traffic signs on Bay View Street, Hillis Ct. & Bird Street.**
Alderperson Oitzinger distributed a diagram with photos of the areas of concern. Oitzinger is asking for additional signage on Bayview and Leonard St and Hillis Ct and Bird St, he is also asking for the existing sign on Bird St be repositioned for better viewing. The committee discussed the current signage and the requests by Alderperson Oitzinger. Chairperson Klegin will meet with Board of Public Works Director Miller to add signage requested by Alderperson Oitzinger
5. **Discussion and possible action regarding an exception for parking on tree lawn during the winter for Noel Forgette, 1449 Sherman Street.**
Distributed at today's meeting is a Permit to Park on Tree Lawn application from Noel Forgette, 1449 Sherman St. Noel is asking to be able to park 4 vehicles on the tree lawn for the winter months. The committee discussed the criteria for the permit to park on Tree Lawns. Alderperson Oitzinger moved/ Mikutowski seconded and all concurred to recommend the Common Council approve to allow Noel Forgette, 1449 Sherman St to park 1 vehicle in the Tree Lawn and approve the permit according to criteria #2 that the Unnecessary hardship is a peculiar property and different from other properties due to unique property limitations.
6. **Discussion & possible action regarding stop sign on Reines Street.**
Included in today's packet is a diagram of the corner in question and a memorandum from City Engineer/Board of Public Works Director Brian Miller with his recommendation to add a stop sign at the corner of Reines and McAllister Streets. Alderperson Oitzinger moved/ Mikutowski seconded and all concurred to recommend the Common Council approve a stop sign at the corner of Reines and McAllister Streets as shown in today's packet.
