

## MARINETTE CIVIC AFFAIRS, CEMETERY, TRAFFIC & LIGHTS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES FROM 11/13/23

1. 6<sup>th</sup> Ward Alderperson Debbie Klegin, Committee Chairperson, **called** the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic and Lights Committee regular meeting **to order** at 04:32 PM in the [Marinette Council Chambers, 1905 Hall Ave, Marinette WI](#).
2. **Upon a call of the roll**, the following Committee members attendance was recorded as follows:

3. **Approving Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee prior month meeting minutes.** Alderpersons Oitzinger moved/Karban seconded and all concurred, (Keller abstained) to approve, as presented, the Civic Affairs, Cemetery, Traffic & Lights Committee regular meeting minutes from 10/16/2023.
4. **Discussion and possible action regarding Permit to park on City tree lawn from Noel Forgette residing at 1449 Sherman St.**  
Alderperson Kowalski moved/Keller seconded and all concurred to recommend the **Common Council approve** the request from Noel Forgette of 1449 Sherman Street for a permit to park one (1) vehicle ('96 Chevrolet van) on the tree lawn due to an unnecessary hardship.
5. **Discussion and possible action regarding reinstalling the light element into the new street Light (46 HH38) on Edwin St.**  
Chairperson Klegin stated the light has been off since October 18<sup>th</sup> and has become unsafe and the street is very dark. Alderperson Keller moved/Kowalski seconded and after a call of the roll **motion carried** by a vote of 3 ayes (Keller, Klegin & Kowalski) to 2 nays (Oitzinger & Karban) to reinstall the light element into the new street light on Edwin St. The committee discussed other options such as moving the light or using a different light known as a "Farm Light" Director of Public Works/City Engineer will check into the option of the "Farm Light" with WI Public Service.
