City of Marinette Residents

Only residents of the City of Marinette may obtain a dump pass. They may only utilize the City Dump to dispose of waste originating from their primary residence, which they own or lease.

A **FREE dump pass** may be obtained at the Community REC Center - You will need a valid Wisconsin driver's license or photo ID, including your current address.

*****Contractors business owners, tax exempt, landlords and government agencies are prohibited from using the city dump.*****

***Dump passes are valid for one year only**

Smaller items must be in a garbage bag or 32 gallon or smaller garbage can, and put out for pick up on Junk Week. There is a six (6) bag/can limit for Junk Week.
